- Advanced presentation skills.

- A Master's Degree in Language Practice, African Languages, Linguistics, English or any equivalent relevant qualification
- A Doctoral Degree in any of the above-mentioned qualifications will be an added advantage.

- Three years lecturing experience within Higher Education is required.
- Full proficiency in the language of teaching is mandatory.
- Paper presentation(s) in local seminars or conferences and publication(s) in DHET accredited journals will also be an added advantage.
