1. Key performance areas:

- Presenting lectures and assessing students in various subjects (Day classes);
- Be responsible for administrative tasks relating to Teaching and Learning;

- Compile and maintain quality study guides, subject files and other relevant Teaching and Learning material;
- Liaise with industry regarding WIL matters;
- Attend departmental meetings as required by the Faculty;
- Setting and marking all assessments;
- General administrative duties such as capturing of test and assignment marks on the ITS system and uploading documents on BrightSpace;
- Consultation with students.

2. Minimum requirements:

Academic qualifications:

- A Master's degree in Applied Languages or equivalent.
- A qualification in Higher Education will be an advantage.

3. Experience:

- At least 2 years teaching experience at a tertiary institution is a requirement.

- Evidence of engagement in scientific research and publications in DHET accredited journals will be an added advantage.
- Registration with a professional body (if applicable).
